Table Tennis Rules and Guidelines

- Each school shall provide four female and four male competitors. Each competitor needs to be ranked Player 1, Player 2, Player 3 and Player 4 according to their skill level.
- The service shall be decided by a toss of a coin.
- Each match consists of 6 sets of 1 game to 21 points with a lead of 2 points as per the official rules.
- Teams will play 4 singles sets and 2 doubles sets in the allocated 30 minutes.
The order is as follows;
(School names have been used in this example)
Set 1: Player 1 from SGC V Player 1 from ASG
Set 2: Player 2 from SGC V Player 2 from ASG
Set 3: Player 3 from SGC V Player 3 from ASG
Set 4: Player 4 from SGC V Player 4 from ASG
Set 5: Doubles Set - Player 1 and 2 from SGC V Player 1 and Player 2 from ASG
Set 6: Doubles Set - Player 3 and 4 from SGC V Player 3 and Player 4 from ASG
- A let is called if a good serve touches the net.
- In doubles, each competitor must play with the same partner in every match.
There is NO swapping of partners during the event.
- The service must go diagonally, from the server's right-hand side to the receiver's right-hand side.
- You have two serves before it is your opponent's turn to serve twice.
- A doubles pair must strike the ball alternately.
- At the change of service, the previous receiver becomes the new server and the partner of the previous server becomes the receiver.
- A Siren will sound to indicate the beginning and end for each round.
- Students will umpire their own match. Any arising disputes should be taken to the competition convenor.
- Score sheets will be filled out by a scorer from the host school and the results will be handed to the results table at the conclusion of each match.
- ALL GAMES MUST BE PLAYED. If teams are even on 3 sets, then the winner will be decided on total points won over all 6 sets.
- If total points are even (over all 6 sets) the team scoring the highest total points over the 4 singles matches will be the winner.

Players Code of Behaviour

1. Learn and play by the official rules of each sport, and any rule modifications made for the Greek Orthodox Archdiocese National Schools Event.
2. In individual or team sports, display good sportsmanship. Respect your opponents and appreciate their good play. Shake hands with your opponent after the event.
3. Accept winning or losing graciously. Be modest in success and appreciate the opponent's performance, even when defeated.
4. Encourage your team mates and players even when they make mistakes. Remember every player makes errors and has off days. Never ridicule opponents or team mates.
5. Respect the time and effort put in by your players, coaches and officials. They deserve your support and full commitment.
6. Never argue with an umpire, opposition player or official. If you have problems discuss it with your coach or team manager. These people can approach the official or umpire.
7. Control your temper. Verbal or physical abuse, swearing and un-sportsmanlike behaviour are reportable actions and will not be tolerated.
8. Play to enjoy the game and improve your skills.
9. Respect the equipment provided for you, it should be used responsibly. Abuse of equipment, such as throwing bats, is a reportable act and will not be tolerated.
10. Set an example. If you want to be treated in a certain manner, then act that way to others. Be encouraging, and fair, and show respect to everyone, as they too have feelings.

Players Code of Behaviour

Coaches Code of Behaviour

1. Ensure that players are aware of the official rules of the game and rule changes that apply to the National Schools Competition.
2. Coaches should recognise that games are for enjoyment, and satisfaction comes from doing one's best for the team. Never ridicule or yell at players for making mistakes or not winning.
3. Role model appropriate behaviour by acting with integrity and professionalism. Remember that the coach is likely to have the greatest influence on the behaviour of players and spectators.
4. Always operate within the rules and spirit of the game, teaching your players to do the same.
5. Display control, respect and professionalism to all involved with the sport. This includes opponents, coaches, officials, administrators, parents, friends and supporters. Encourage your players to do the same.
6. Be reasonable in your demands on your player's time, energy and enthusiasm.
7. Coaches should remove from the playing arena those players who are losing their composure and becoming too physical.
8. Coaches are to accept player safety as an essential priority and correct techniques are to be encouraged. Under no circumstances are matches to start or to continue under conditions which a coach considers contentious.
9. Be responsible for the conduct of your team members at practice sessions and games.
10. Discuss any coaching problems with the Sports Coordinator.
11. Supervise the practice fields, courts or dressing rooms until all their players have left.
12. Be familiar with the official rules of the sport being coached.
13. When a player is injured, the coach shall supervise his/her condition and administer First Aid only until qualified personnel take over. In all cases of severe injury, the parents and the Sports Coordinator shall be notified immediately. A complete record of all injuries will be kept by the Sports Coordinator.
14. Coaches are to ensure that spectators from each school do not interfere with the conduct of the event, only provide positive support, and leave the area free of litter at the conclusion of an event.

Parents and Spectators Code of Behaviour

1. Applaud good play from both teams and encourage your child to accept that their best and honest effort is just as important as victory.
2. Respect the official's decision, regardless of your opinion. Sometimes (like anyone) an umpire's decision may be wrong. Accept this part of the game and encourage players to participate as good sports.
3. Never ridicule, abuse or yell at any player for making a mistake which may change the result of the game.
4. Offensive language and behaviour from parents and spectators is not acceptable under any circumstances and the team concerned should take immediate stern action.
5. Respect the wishes of the Conveners at any venue in relation to playing areas, designated spectator areas and any other requirements which may be specific to the venue.
6. Courtesy should be shown towards staff members.
7. Visitors should leave a school, or other sporting venues, tidy and rubbish free.

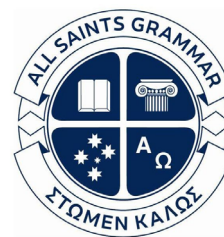
